Village defibrillator at the Village Hall

- If you need the defibrillator to deal with an emergency cardiac arrest do the following:
- · Go to the box on the village hall wall
- Dial 999 and tell them the code on the box
- They will then know which box it is and give you the code to open it using the keypad on the front of the box
- Also ask for an ambulance
- Take the equipment to the emergency and it will talk you through what to do
- The defibrillator will know if the patient has not had a cardiac arrest



VILLAGE HALL SPONSOR A CHAIR APPEAL

The next phase of the village hall refurbishment is the replacement of our increasingly wobbly chairs. To do this we need to raise serious funds. We received a grant of £500 from the Parish Council but we need to buy at least 60 chairs at £30-£40 each.



The Village Hall has recently purchased a small number of toddler size chairs and a low table useful for children's art and craft work.

We'll be holding fundraisers but also asking village organisations, businesses and individuals if they will support us by sponsoring a chair, or part of a chair or more than one chair. The fundraising activities will be launched at the August Social Saturday on 25 August. We hope that we will have a chair to view on the day.

PLANNING

Anaerobic Digester (AD) Plant proposal at Park Farm, Holme on Spalding Moor: Request from concerned residents of HOSM

There is a proposed VARIATION to the original permission, which will increase the tonnage of waste from the approved 30k to 80k. This is a significant increase of 166% and is actually greater than the original application of 70k, which was refused by ERYC.

The proposed increase in tonnage would take the AD Plant to a huge Industrial size, non-agricultural looking monstrosity which can be seen for miles and will be working 24/7/365. The site is just off the A614 where it curves round the bottom of Church Hill and is not far from Seaton Ross as the crow flies.

AD plants have a number of issues, one of which is odour, there have been numerous reports of residents near such plants being affected by the smell. Prevalent winds may result in the odour having an impact on your village life. The increased size of the plant will also significantly increase the number of lorries on the local roads.

HOSM residents ask for your support in opposing this application as the East Riding Councillors don't seem to listen to our concerns about it. Please add your concerns to the Planning Portal – the application reference is **18/01443/CM.** Many Thanks.
