BUS SERVICE UPDATE

Changes to bus services from 1 April. EYRC has decided the subsidised 195 service will cease. Instead, Pocklington MiBus (a dial a ride service) will run on Tuesdays to Pocklington and on Thursdays to Sutton on Derwent where passengers will swap to the 196 from Aughton to complete the journey to York. There is still some consultation to be held with East Yorkshire Motor Services but this seems unlikely to change anything. The times are to be confirmed.
