South End will be closed for road repairs from 4th March for up to a month.

EYRC has made an order to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along the entire length of South End, Seaton Ross between Southfield Lane and Church Lane commencing 4th March 2019

The road closure is necessary to enable carriageway repairs to be carried out in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public. The Order is valid for 18 months, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed within 1 Month.

The closure will be in place between the hours of 08:00 and 17:00 only

For the alternative route for traffic affected by the road closure see the map on the village website. The diversion route will be signed at the time of closure. The road will be closed to all traffic but access will be maintained for emergency vehicles, pedestrians and properties affected by the closure.
