### POCKLINGTON CANAL BRIDGE AND HAGG BRIDGE – WORKS STARTS 23 MARCH 2020



Planning permission has been granted to construct a concrete slab over the Pocklington Canal Bridge and Hagg Bridge, strengthening both structures and allowing a bespoke vehicle restraint system to be installed which is in keeping with the Grade II listed structures. Due to the narrow carriageway, permanent traffic lights will be installed. **Duration: Approx. 6 months.**
