Harvest Festivals: There will be no Harvest Festivals as such this year, but this Sunday at Everingham and HoSM will have a harvest theme

Patronal Festival: All Saints' Day falls on a Sunday this year, so on November 1 there will only be one service, Patronal Festival Communion at 10.45 at HoSM.

All Souls' Day: Monday November 2. There will be the usual commemoration of the faithful departed at 19.00 at HoSM. Lists are available at the back of the churches to write the names of those to be remembered; or else drop Stephen an email or give him a ring (but not this week!).

Everingham APCM: Friday November 6, 19.30, in church.

Remembrance Sunday: Most services on November 8 will be outside, but at HoSM we will be in church at 10.50 as usual. Because of restrictions on numbers, attendance will be limited. Please book your attendance with Stephen (and say how many will be in your bubble), and please inform others, especially those not on social media.

Food Bank: *The People's Pantry* in HoSM is a delivery service: if anyone is in need, they can contact Stephen on any day with a shopping list and he (or another volunteer) will deliver. Donations of non-perishable food, cleaning materials and toiletries can be dropped off at Margaret's DIY in HoSM, at the back of Seaton Ross church (when open), or on the Vicarage doorstep (but not this week!).

Holy Communion: Holy Communion will be administered in one kind only, and the communicants will receive into the hand, standing. The person administering Communion will sanitise hands before and after and will wear a mask, and will strive to avoid touching anyone's hands. Please keep your distance from others as best you can when going to and from Communion.
