Remembrance Sunday: Some services next Sunday, November 8, will be outside, but at HoSM we will be in church at 10.50 as usual. Because of restrictions on numbers, attendance at HoSM will be limited. Please book your attendance with Stephen (and say how many will be in your bubble), and please inform others, especially those not on social media.

Patronal Festival: St Edmund's Day is Friday November 20, and there will be Patronal Festival Communion at Seaton Ross at 19.30. Sadly, no refreshments afterwards.

Please keep your distance from others when going to and from Communion.
