Good news! KCOM have confirmed that they will bring Fibre to the Premise (FTTP) to Seaton Ross. The FTTP service brings fibre all the way to your home with speed offerings up to 900Mbps and much more reliable

Activities are now underway to plan the build, which may commence this year with connections early spring. KCOM are using the Department of Digital, Culture, Media & Sport (DCMS) Gigabit broadband scheme. This enables rural communities to obtain funding to bring gigabit capable speeds to these harder to reach areas. KCOM are in the process of approving a project with DCMS. Once approved residents will need to give their permission for KCOM to use a voucher for their connection.
