So please join us at the village hall @1.30pm on 10th April to collect equipment and help make our village litter free.

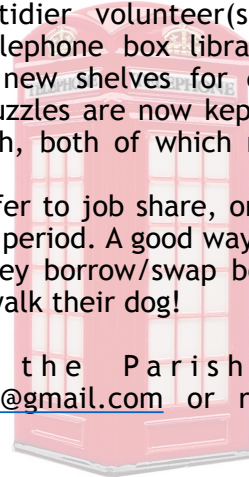


## Telephone box
