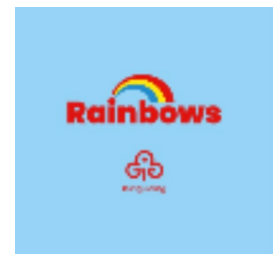
Local Girlguiding Opportunities

There are so **many reasons to join Girlguiding**.

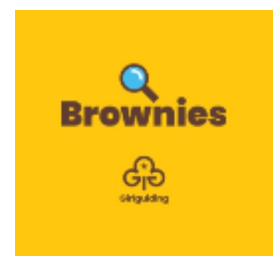

1st Melbourne Rainbows will be **re opening September 2024** for girls aged **4-7 years**. Meetings will take place **4:30-5:30pm**.

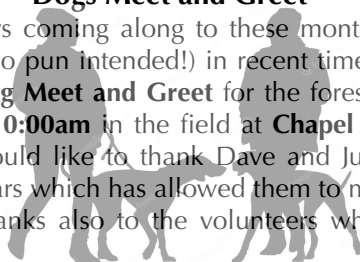


1st Melbourne Brownies have spaces for girls aged **7-10 years**. Meetings will take place **6:00-7:15pm**.
