SEATON ROSS VILLAGE HALL AT RISK OF CLOSING

VOLUNTEER TRUSTEES URGENTLY REQUIRED

- Seaton Ross Village Hall is a registered charity and requires a group of Trustees, associates and other helpers to keep it running. To continue to provide our community with this valuable space, we are now looking for new Volunteer Trustees.
 - There are currently 6 Trustees for the Village Hall. However, 3 long-standing Trustees are due to step down (retire) at the next AGM. The remaining 3 Trustees are not enough to run the hall. If we do not get the required number of people volunteering for the committee, the hall **WILL** have to **CLOSE**.
 - This is a chance for you to help and support your community by becoming a Trustee. The role of Trustee is not a life-long commitment, in fact you can do this for one year only, or become a committee member without becoming a full Trustee.

There will be some demonstrations of how to treat common first aid incidents such as heavy bleeding, choking and burns as well as the use of CPR and the defibrillator. They will take place on **Wednesday 16th October** (please note the **change in date** from the last SRT) and **Wednesday 13th November** in **Seaton Ross Village Hall, 7:00–8:30pm**.
